FUND OBJECTIVE, STRATEGY AND RISKS (Class AH EUR)

The product aims to increase the value of your investment over the long term

Under normal market conditions, the main part of the product is invested in convertible bonds and/or other fixed-income securities, bank deposits and warrants or call options or shares and, up to a maximum of 10% of the assets of the product, in units of collective investment undertakings representing these asset classes. The product may also invest in shares and other equity-linked securities and use derivatives for investment purposes or to reduce investment risk (hedging). Based on criteria such as innovation, quality of management, valuation and leadership, the manager selects companies around the world that it believes have strong growth prospects or are undervalued. The product invests in a concentrated portfolio of shares of these companies and/or instruments convertible into shares or giving the right to acquire shares of these companies. The manager's objective is to hedge positions in currencies other than EUR representing more than 2.5% of the net asset value of the product.

You may place orders to buy or sell the product on a daily basis.

This product does not distribute dividends (which means that the income generated is added to the price of the product).

The product is aimed at individual investors wishing to invest for the long term (we recommend an investment horizon of 5 years). The investor must have a good knowledge of the risks associated with financial markets and be prepared to accept capital losses due to fluctuations in the value of the assets in the portfolio.

These objectives as well as the investment policy are an exact copy of those indicated in the corresponding KID.

The product is actively managed.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements

in the markets or because we are not able to pay you. We have classified this product as 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class. This indicator assesses potential losses in future returns at a mediumlow level, and it is unlikely that poor market conditions will affect the value of the shares in which the product invests and therefore the value of the product itself.

This level of risk reflects the fact that the product invests in shares and/or other instruments (such as more volatile warrants and convertible bonds), may invest in a limited number of securities and may favor particular economic sectors or regions. Moreover, the product may invest a part of its portfolio in warrants or call options on shares that are more volatile than shares and may loose their value at expiry date.
