The product aims to increase the value of your investment over the long term

Under normal market conditions, the product invests primarily in shares of issuers around the world, including emerging markets. It also invests in other types of securities consistent with its investment objective. The product may also use derivatives for investment purposes or to reduce investment risk (hedging). The product invests in a portfolio of approximately 50 stocks and consists mainly of stocks of multinational companies offering a high dividend yield and/or instruments convertible into shares or giving the right to acquire shares of these companies. 


